## Introduction

This Cookies Policy is intended for those browsing/using <https://mglwallet.com/> owned and operated by MGL WALLET LTD, a Company registered in the Republic of Cyprus operating under EMI license number 115.1.3.34 issued by the Central Bank of Cyprus (hereinafter the “**CBC**”) and residing at 71 Agias Fylaxeos &, Arch. Makarios III Avenue, Safe Bulkers Tower, Office 201, 3087, Limassol, Cyprus, hereinafter named “**we**”, “**our**” or “**us**”, to assist our web site users with knowing our cookies policy.

We believe in being clear and open about how we collect and use data related to you. In the spirit of transparency, this policy provides detailed information about how and when we use cookies.

### 1. What is a cookie

A cookie is a small piece of data or message that is sent from an organisation's web server to your web browser and is then stored on your hard drive. Cookies can't read data off your hard drive or cookie files created by other sites, and do not damage your system.

### 2. Different Categories of cookies

- **Necessary cookies:** They help to make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.
- **Session cookies:** They are stored temporarily on a user's device to gather information in relation to the browsing activity and input information of the user within the website. This is to remember user's input information, to avoid re-entering such information. As soon as the user closes the browser, session cookies are deleted from his device.
- **Statistic cookies:** They help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously

Statistic Cookies	<i>cookies-statistic</i>	They help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously
